Safe Routes:

Lynette Risk will be taking on AAA Safety Patrol. She is interested in taking on leadership opportunities for 5th and 6th grade and thinks this will be a good fit.

There was some discussion on 2200N. Rachel Luke advised anyone with an opinion about 2200 N (widening to 5 lanes/traffic light installation/roundabout) to write the Provo City Council with the email council@provo.org.

Trustlands Plan (Mini Grants): Community council went through all of the mini grants submitted by teachers to be fulfilled by trustland funds. Trustland funds for the year are around \$77,000 and we typically spend \$43,000 of that on aides. We have about \$16,000 to be allocated towards teacher mini grants. We have no tech replacement needs for 2020-2021.

Below is a shortened summary of mini grant requests. Lisa Dahl plans to edit the google document to better reflect costs.

1st Grade- Our hope is to get 6 (working) iPads per classroom to implement the listening and fluency state standards for 1st Grade. Having individual iPads will allow students to read at their own personal level and advance at their own pace through various texts and activities. We plan to use the free software, Epic. We need the iPads to run the program.

2nd-30 Chromebooks and any required hardware/software.

2nd- Having a teacher more knowledgeable in computer technology, who can manage and teach all students at Rock Canyon Elementary.

3rd-software/registration for 2 sites and programmable devices I already have, a class set of headphones.

4th- 3 Quality document cameras that will be supported on the Provo network for as long as possible.

5th- We need funding for the buses to take all 3 fifth grade classes at Rock Canyon to the Natural History Museum and State Capitol in Salt Lake City. The total cost is around \$800 for 2 buses. The mini-grant will allow us to request less of a donation from the students and their

families. (or none at all)

Art- Batteries, copper tape. small light bulbs for a STEAM project

Kindergarten- sensory table and supportive materials (kinetic sand, water toys etc)

Kindergarten- Bee Bots, hands-on science materials to help explore nature, earth and space science, forces of motion and organisms that change over time.

Media/Library- Books is both areas. Specifically informational books in areas such as Sports, Art & Crafts, Coding, Science, Drawing, Technology , Languages, and Animals. Battle of the Books books and supplies.
