LIBRARY CORNER

Hello and welcome back! We are so excited to try some new programs this year: BookHub (think Grubhub), Destiny Discover on-line, and Virtual Pop-In Storytime.

BookHub and Destiny Discover will allow students to safely check out books. Students in K-3 will order their books from a “book menu,” while students in grades 4-6 will be able to place books on hold using Destiny Discover. The library staff will then locate the books, load them into class totes, and then deliver them to each class.

Our Virtual Pop-In Storytimes are held Monday through Thursday at 10 am and 1 pm for students who are learning from home on those days. During each 20-minute session, the librarians will share new books and upcoming events and read a book or two. The Zoom link is: bit.ly/3iTVj7S and the passcode is 6LC1H7.
